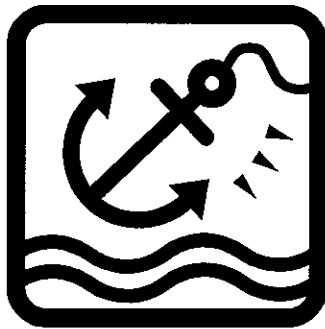


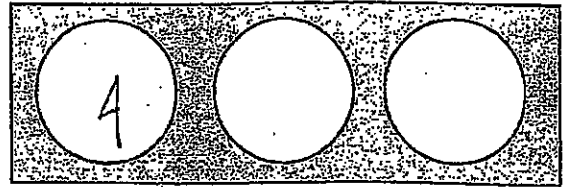

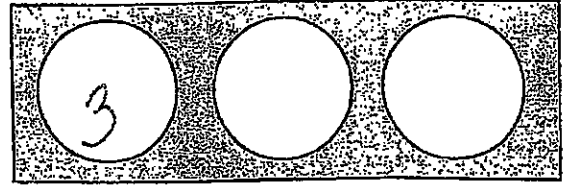
Additionally, students being nosy and want to know everyone's ~~has~~ ^{mess} causes gossip. When

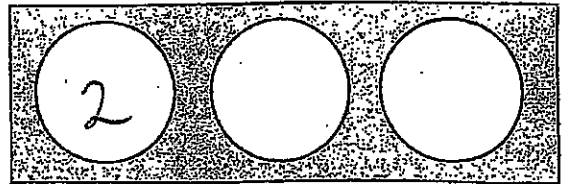

What you can do if they discriminated you?

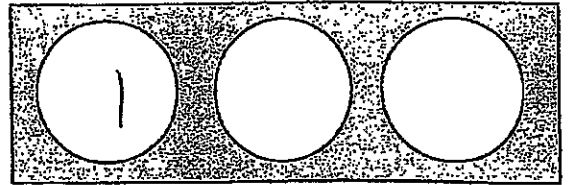
